The celebration assembly starts at 11.40am every Friday, everyone is welcome.

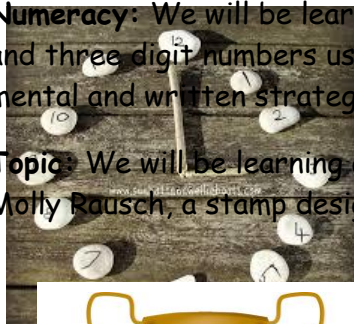
Please can we ask that children do not arrive before 8.50am as the Teachers are busy preparing for the day ahead. Thank you for your continued co-operation.
