Literacy: Within literacy we will be writing a book review of the Lighthouse Keepers Lunch. We will begin to discuss and plan our own sustained stories, thinking about the characters, setting and events.

Numeracy: We will be learning how to add and subtract one, two and three digit numbers using practical and informal written methods. We will also be using units of time, recognising the relationships between them.

Topic: Within science we will be recognising that living things grow and reproduce and that there can be changes in living things, giving reasons for examples. During art we will be exploring the use of different materials and the techniques we can use to represent seaside features. Within design and technology we will begin to make our lighthouse designs. During history, we will be learning about the life of Grace Darling, writing a diary account of the event she is famous for.
