The money raised through the Smartie tube collection will be given to Osmond from the New Life Church, who runs a children's home and school for some of the poorest children in Ghana aged 2 -13. To change lives, he needs to provide a senior high school for the pupils to complete their schooling. The funds raised will be used so that each child in the home can have a full kit including clothing, uniform, shoes, nightwear, bedlinen, toiletries and gardening equipment.

On Tuesday afternoon next week two musicians from Music for Life are coming to do a workshop and concert for the whole school. Stewart Hardy plays the fiddle in many Northumbrian folk groups and is also a teacher of the fiddle. He will be joined by Sophy Ball who is also a fiddle player. She is an experienced workshop leader and teacher, performs in several bands and is also a former winner of the Young Folk Award with the Folk and Ceildh band The Pack and 422. The afternoon will start with a concert, followed by a workshop and parents will be welcome to join us from 3.10pm for the children to share what they have learnt.
