Class 1

Literacy: This week we will be completing our explanation texts, using what we have learnt to ensure we have achieved our success criteria.

Topic: This week we will be using our design ideas gathered during art, design technology and geography to begin making our products.

Class 2

Literacy: Writing poems linked to our topic. We will also be revising prefixes, clauses and apostrophes.

Numeracy: The children will be learning about mental maths strategies, shape and written methods for the four operations - addition, subtraction, division and multiplication.

Topic: We had an amazing trip out to Harlow Carr gardens where the children learned about habitats through becoming ecological scientists. They said it was 'the best trip ever!' They also had a visit from a group of Year 8 Geography students from Thirsk Secondary School, who came to work with the children on designing bee houses - fabulous! Next week we will continue with our 'Gardener's World' learning.
